



Eros, organic wine with a lovely pink color. Produced in a natural way from a blend of red grapes, grown on the slopes of the famous Colle dei Cipressi di Solferino and the ancient Gonzaga Castle, a territory that was several times the scene of encounters and clashes between different cultures and always been a landscape dominated by vineyards. Eros di Solimago is the wine that we were looking for, it is a recent creation wanted by the current heirs of the Costanza-Fattori estate.

Fresh, soft and velvety as it should be for a rosé wine.

In the head white peach and red fruits aromas, then the notes of black cherry and pomegranate emerge then a final note of bitter almond spreads out in the mouth, truly a surprising aromatic and gustatory range.

A wine calibrated for elegant aperitifs and plant-based candlelight dinners.

Vineyard: On gravelly morainic soil. Guyot trained vines.

Harvest: Early, with selective harvesting by hand.

Vinification: Soft pressing and slow fermentation in steel at a controlled temperature.

Aging: In steel and in glass.
